



Apprenticeship FAQ's

How long will it take me to gain my Apprenticeship?

This depends on the level taken and your individual learning needs and commitment.

On average it takes 12 - 15 months to achieve an Apprenticeship (level 2) and 18 - 26 months to achieve an Advanced Apprenticeship (level 3).

What qualifications do I need to start my Apprenticeship?

There are no entry requirements needed to start your Apprenticeship, but gaining GCSE's in maths and English will reduce the amount of work you will have to do.

How do I arrange my work placement?

If you do not already have a work placement we would ask that you make every effort to find one close to where you live. If you experience problems VTS can provide you with contact lists of facilities in your area and may occasionally be able to arrange an interview.

Will I have to attend college?

No, but by attending you will be able to receive additional support and guidance from the VTS team.
